Your Road to P.Eng./P.Geo. Engineering and Geoscientist Credential Recognition Process in Manitoba

1. Overview

This presentation focuses on the Engineers Geoscientists Manitoba's academic assessment process and requirements for internationally trained engineer or geoscientists. The presentation includes the various options that maybe available to get a foreign acquired engineering or geoscientist credential recognized as well as the requirements to become a licensed Professional Engineer or Geoscientist in Manitoba.

2. Our Speaker – Ray Sator, P.Eng., MBA
